## (Angmering: A259 Amendment) Order 2022 And A259 Proposed Pedestrian Crossing Places

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make two permanent Traffic Regulation Orders under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the first Order will be to prohibit vehicles from making right turns from Oliver Acre, Cornfield Close and Windroos Drive in Littlehampton onto the A259 and visa-versa. The Order also consolidates the provisions of previous similar orders affecting the A259 and various side roads between Littlehampton and Ferring. The opportunity is also being taken to update the existing one-way traffic restriction on the northern end of Dappers Lane in Angmering, to remove an exemption for buses which is no longer required.

The effect of the second Order will be to introduce a 24-hour clearway restriction on the A259 in Angmering, from its junction with the A280, westwards to its junction with Station Road.

It is also proposed to install two new Toucan crossings for pedestrians and cycles on the A259 in Angmering. The first would be located approximately 50 metres east of the roundabout at its junction with Station Road. The second crossing would be located approximately 90 metres west of its junction with the A280.

Due to current social distancing requirements, paper copies of documents will not be available to view in council offices or libraries. ## A259 Proposed Pedestrian Crossing Places STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

West Sussex County Council proposes to make two permanent Traffic Regulation Orders.

The effect of the first Order will be to prohibit vehicles from making right turns from Oliver Acre, Cornfield Close and Windroos Drive in Littlehampton onto the A259 and visa-versa. The Order also consolidates the provisions of previous similar orders affecting the A259 and various side roads between Littlehampton and Ferring.

The opportunity is also being taken to update the existing one-way traffic restriction on the northern end of Dappers Lane in Angmering, to remove an exemption for buses which is no longer required as there is no longer a bus route operating in the road. Modifying the Order in this way will permit clearer signage to be installed, with the intention of reducing the number of vehicles proceeding in contravention of the restriction.

The effect of the second Order will be to introduce a 24-hour clearway restriction on the A259 in Angmering, from its junction with the A280, westwards to its junction with Station Road.

Construction has begun on a project to upgrade the single carriageway sections of the A259 between its junctions with the A280 and Station Road in Angmering, and from its junctions with Horsham Road (Bodyshop Roundabout) and the new Lyminster bypass in Littlehampton.

These sections of roads will be widened to become dual carriageways with a central reservation, and this will require amendments to the access arrangements at junctions on the affected lengths of roads. The safest arrangement at these new junctions is to arrange them as 'left in – left out' and this is formalised by the restrictions proposed in the first Order.

This Order also consolidates the existing restrictions on other junctions along the A259 between Ferring and Littlehampton. This part of the order does not change the existing restrictions but is being made to bring them into one Order for ease of reference.

The second Order enacts a 24-hour clearway restriction, which has the effect of prohibiting parking on the carriageway of the newly widened section of road, where stationary vehicles would cause obstruction and a potential hazard due to the speed limit of the road.

The new Orders are therefore proposed to facilitate the passage of traffic and avoiding danger to traffic using the affected length of road.

It is also proposed to install two new Toucan crossings for pedestrians and cycles on the A259 in Angmering. The first would be located approximately 50 metres east of the

roundabout at its junction with Station Road. The second crossing would be located approximately 90 metres west of its junction with the A280.

As part of the scheme to improve the A259, new shared use pedestrian/cycle paths will be constructed on both sides of the A259. The new crossings are both proposed at locations where pedestrians and cyclists are likely to cross the road to access other routes or local amenities.

The attached drawings, numbered TQ0603SES, TQ0603SWS, TQ0703SEN, TQ0703SES and TQ0703SWS show the lengths of roads affected by the proposed clearway Order. Drawings are also attached showing the junctions affected by the prohibitions of right turns, and the locations of the proposed new crossings.

## WEST SUSSEX COUTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS PARISHES: A259) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (AND CONSOLIDATION) AND (ANGMERING: DAPPERS LANE) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 (1) 2 (1) and (2), 4 (2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

### PART 1 General

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the \*\* day of \*\*\*\*\*\* 2022 and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Various Parishes: A259) (Traffic Regulation) (And Consolidation) and (Angmering: Dappers Lane) (One Way Traffic) Order 2022" hereinafter called "this Order".
- 2. The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under an enactment.
- 3. In this Order -
  - "Public Service Vehicle" shall have the same meaning as in section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 as amended.
  - "Pedal Cycle" shall have the same meaning as defined in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 4. The Orders specified in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.

### PART 2 Prohibition of Right Turn Provisions

5. Save as provided in Article 11, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to make a right turn as specified in the Second Schedule of this Order.

### PART 3 Prohibition of Driving Except for Local Buses

- 6. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 11, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the length of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- 7. Nothing in Article 6 shall apply to a Public Service Vehicle in operating a local service.

### PART 4 Prohibition of U-Turns

8. Save as provided in Article 11, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to make a U-Turn as described in the Fourth Schedule to this Order.

### PART 5 One Way Traffic

- 9. Save as provided in Articles 10 and 11, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in column 1 of the Fifth Schedule to this Order, in a direction other than specified in column 2 of the Fifth Schedule to this Order.
- 10. Nothing in Article 10 shall apply to a pedal cycle proceeding in a designated cycle lane.

### PART 6 General Exemptions

- 11. Nothing in Articles 5, 6 and 8 shall apply to:
  - (a) A vehicle proceeding under the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform; or
  - (b) A vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in the event of an emergency.
