West Sussex County Council (Henfield and Woodmancote: A281 and A2037) (40 MPH and 50 MPH Speed Limits) (and Consolidation) Order 2022

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce new speed limits on roads in Henfield and Woodmancote as follows:

- A) to introduce a 40 mph speed limit on Brighton Road (A281) from 140m east of Mill Drive, eastwards to 685m west of its junction with Clappers Lane
- B) to introduce a 50 mph speed limit on Brighton Road (A281) from 685m west of its junction of Clappers Lane, eastwards for 800m.

The order also consolidates the existing 30 mph speed limits on the A281, and the 40 mph speed limit on the A2037 on the approaches to Henfield for housekeeping purposes.

West Sussex County Council (Henfield and Woodmancote: A281 and A2037) (40 MPH and 50 MPH Speed Limits) (and Consolidation) Order 2022

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce new speed limits on roads in Henfield and Woodmancote as follows:

- A) Introduce a 40 mph speed limit on Brighton Road (A281) from 140m east of Mill Drive, eastwards to 685m west of its junction with Clappers Lane
- B) Introduce a 50 mph speed limit on Brighton Road (A281) from 685m west of its junction of Clappers Lane, eastwards for 800m.

Woodmancote Parish council requested a review of the existing speed limits on the A281 through the West Sussex County Council community highway scheme procedure. A review has been carried out considering the current speed limits and the speed limits redesigned to meet local concerns about vehicle speeds in keeping with the WSCC speed limit policy.

The order also consolidates the existing 30 mph speed limits on the A281, and the 40 mph speed limit on the A2037 on the approaches to Henfield. These restrictions are contained in the same order as the existing 40 and 50 mph speed limits on the A281 and it is proposed to carry them over into the new Order unchanged for housekeeping purposes.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road and to preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

The attached drawing, numbered 14402-002-GA shows the lengths of road affected by the proposed order.

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (HENFIELD AND WOODMANCOTE: A281 AND A2037) (40 MPH AND 50 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (AND CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2022

West Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 (1) a of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the ***** day of ****** 2022 and may be cited as "West Sussex County Council (Henfield and Woodmancote: A281 and A2037) (40 MPH and 50 mph speed limits) (And Consolidation) Order 2022"
- 2. The Order Specified in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 4. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- 5. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the length of road specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order.
- 6. Nothing in Paragraphs 3, 4 or 5 shall apply to a vehicle being used by naval, military or air force purposes while being driven by a person for the timebeing subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown on an occasion when
 - (a) the person driving the vehicle is a member of the special forces as defined by the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) the vehicle is being driven-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.
