NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce new parking restrictions in Worthing as follows:

Broadwater Street West: To limit waiting to a maximum stay of 2 hours, no return within 2 hours 8.30am to 6pm Mon-Sat in the parking areas on both sides of the road between its junctions with South Farm Road and Ardsheal Road and to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on the central reservation of the road, and various lengths of both sides of the road, including at the junctions of Grove Road and Lamorna Grove.

South Farm Road: To Prohibit waiting at any time on throughout the eastern side of the road from its junction with Broadwater Street West to its junction with Ardsheal Road and on the western side of the road at its junction with Poulters Lane.

The double yellow line restrictions described above would also extend a short distance into Grove Road, Lamorna Grove and Poulters Lane.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce new parking restrictions in Worthing as follows:

Broadwater Street West: To limit waiting to a maximum stay of 2 hours, no return within 2 hours 8.30am to 6pm Mon-Sat in the parking areas on both sides of the road between its junctions with South Farm Road and Ardsheal Road and to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on the central reservation of the road, and various lengths of both sides of the road, including at the junctions of Grove Road and Lamorna Grove.

South Farm Road: To Prohibit waiting at any time on throughout the eastern side of the road from its junction with Broadwater Street West to its junction with Ardsheal Road and on the western side of the road at its junction with Poulters Lane.

The double yellow line restrictions described above would also extend a short distance into Grove Road, Lamorna Grove and Poulters Lane.

The roads which run round Broadwater Green are mostly available for unrestricted parking. Broadwater Street West in particular is frequently used for the long-term storage of large vehicles, such as horseboxes, advertising vehicles and ex-army lorries. This monopolises available parking around Broadwater Green, leaving no parking available for visitors to the local shops, school and residential properties.

The proposed restrictions will resolve this issue by introducing a limited waiting restriction to create a turnover of parking and increase the availability parking spaces for people visiting amenities in the area. The opportunity is also being taken to install waiting restrictions at junctions and other lengths of roads on which parking displaced by new restrictions would cause obstruction.

The new order is therefore proposed to preserve or improve the amenities of the area through which the roads run and to facilitate the passage of traffic.

The attached drawings, numbered TQ1404NWN and TQ1404NWS show the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.

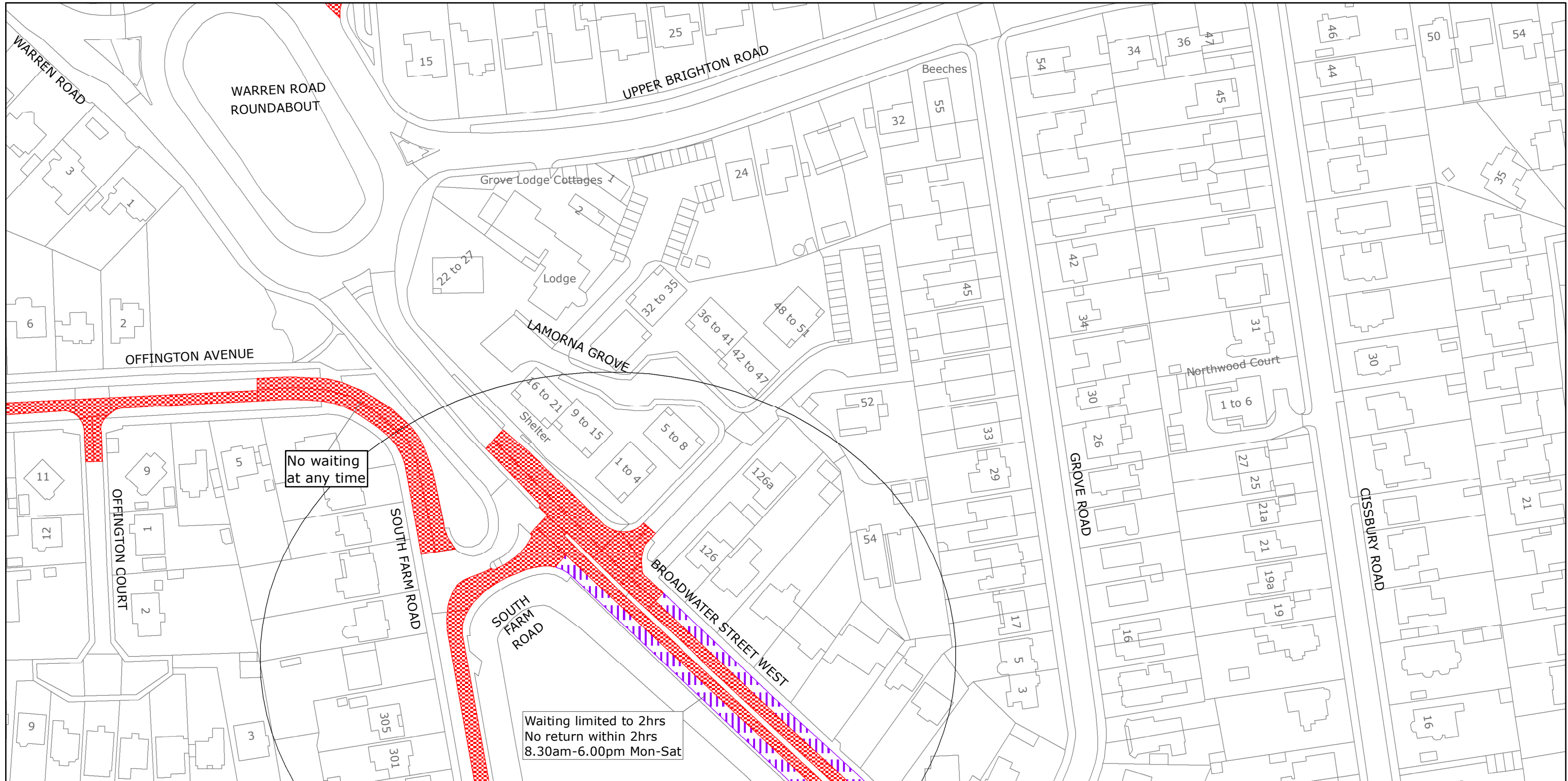

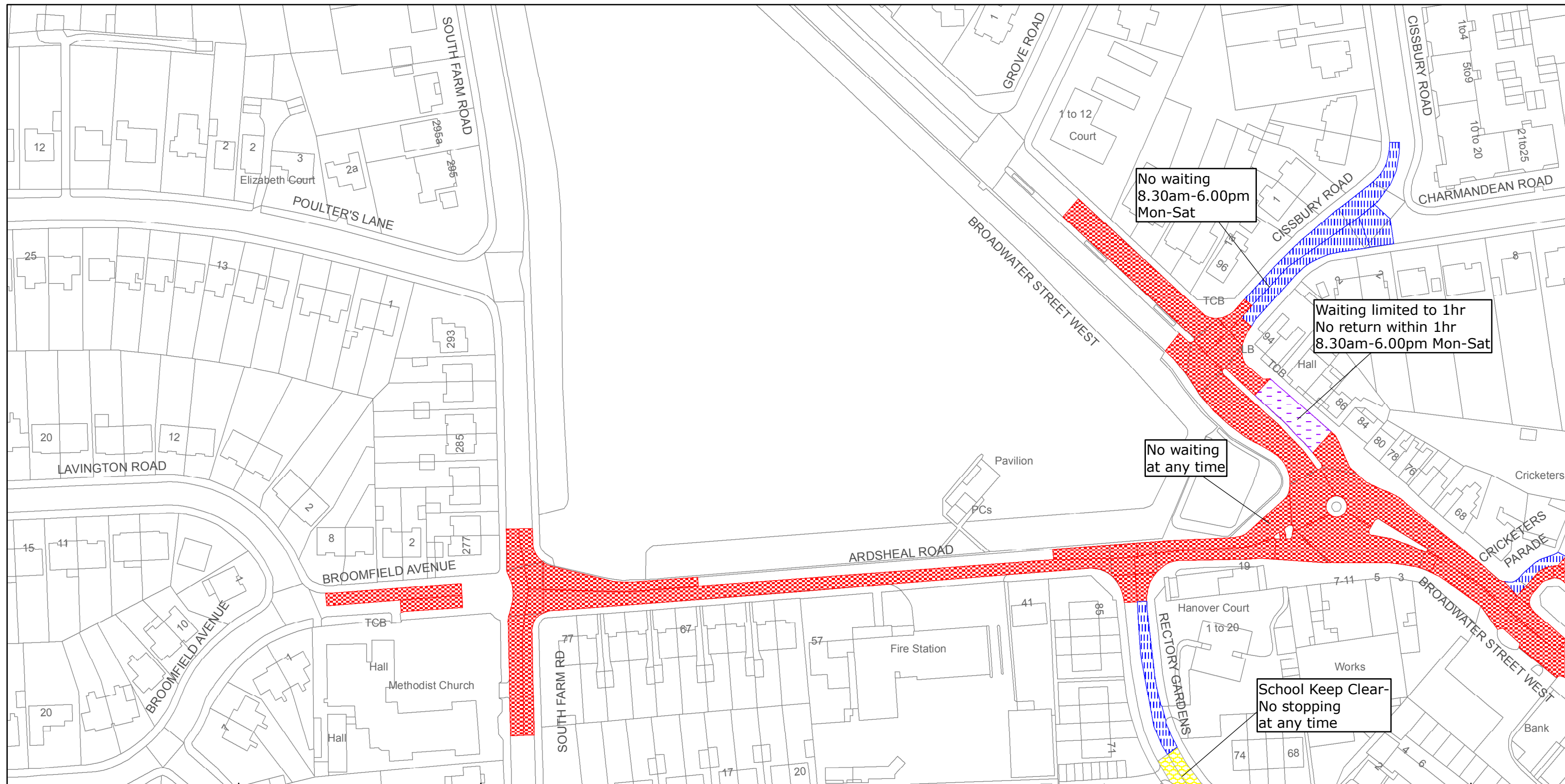

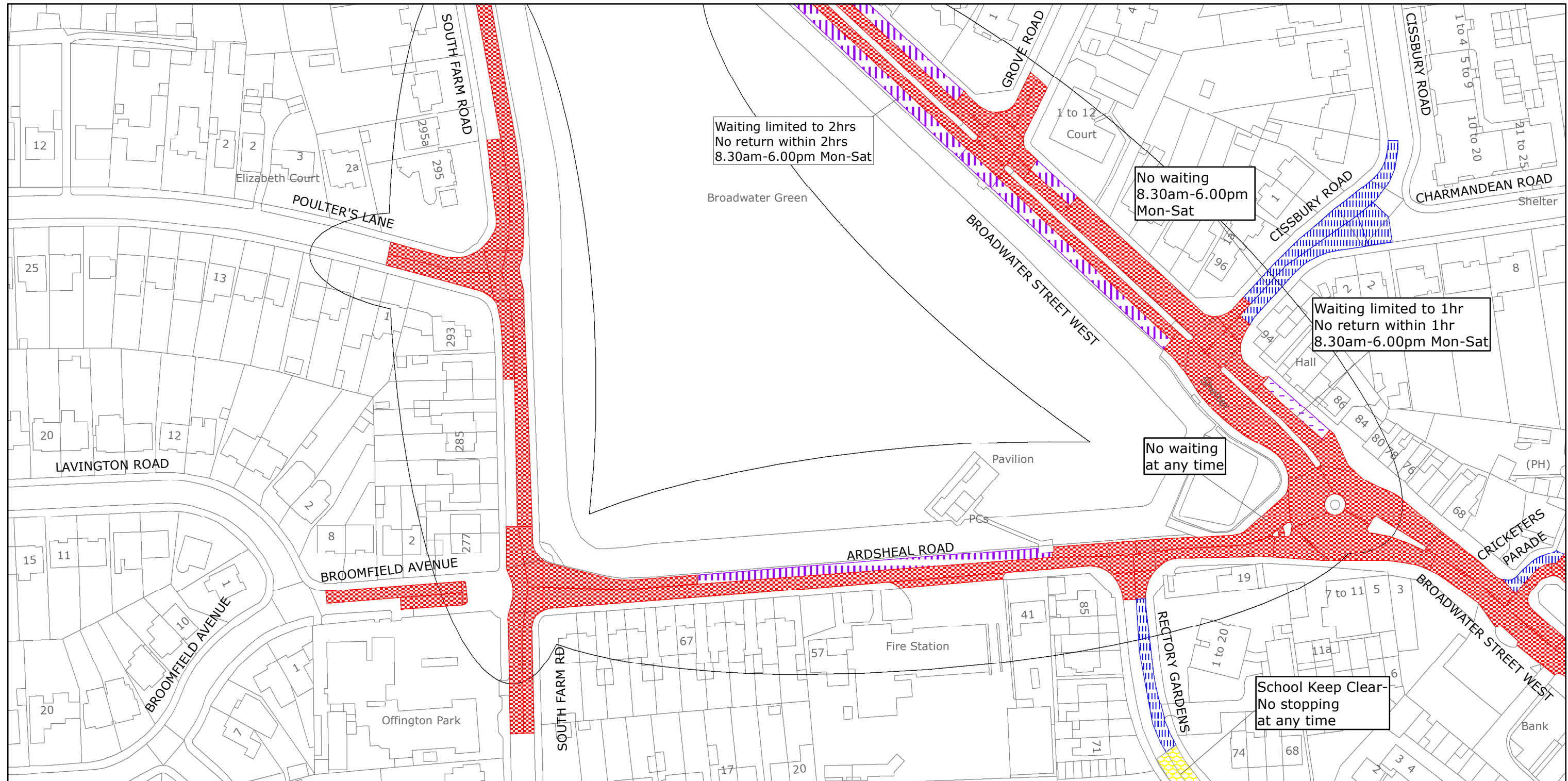
