(Various Roads: Electric Vehicle Charging Amendment) Order 2022

NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce parking bays for use only by electric vehicles being recharged at any time on the following roads in Adur District:

LANCING: Freshbrook Road (south side near the junction of Russels Drive), Hayley Road (east side near the junction of Lisher Road) Winston Road (east side near the junction of West End Way). SHOREHAM/SOUTHWICK: Cromleigh Way (north side, east of Overhill), Downsway (east side near junction of Edburton Gardens), Harbour Way (a; north side near junction of Emerald Quay & b; north side near junction of The Moorings), Highdown (north side near junction with Highdown Close). SOMPTING: Millfield (west side near the junction of Rectory Farm Road), Test Road (north side near Hamble Road junction), Whitestyles Road (east side between its junctions with Blacksmiths Road).

At each of these locations it is proposed to install on-street electric vehicle charging points. Each bay will accommodate six vehicles.

Full details of the proposals, including detailed plans showing the location of the proposed bays, can be viewed on the Traffic Regulation Order page of the West Sussex County Council website. The <u>website</u> includes a response form for any comments or objections.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will introduce parking bays for use only by electric vehicles being recharged at any time on the following roads in Adur District:

LANCING: Freshbrook Road (south side near the junction of Russels Drive), Hayley Road (east side near the junction of Lisher Road) Winston Road (east side near the junction of West End Way). SHOREHAM/SOUTHWICK: Cromleigh Way (north side, east of Overhill). Downsway (east side near junction of Edburton Gardens), Harbour Way (a; north side near junction of Emerald Quay & b; north side near junction of The Moorings), Highdown (north side near junction with Highdown Close). SOMPTING: Millfield (west side near the junction of Rectory Farm Road), Test Road (north side near Hamble Road junction), Whitestyles Road (east side between its junctions with Blacksmiths Road).

West Sussex County Council is committed to encouraging the use of electric vehicles and to providing charging facilities to make their use as convenient as possible. A partnership agreement has been entered into with Connected Kerb, who will meet the cost of installing and maintaining electric vehicle charging points in car parks and on-street locations across the county.

More information about the project and how the charge points will operate is available on the Electric Vehicle page of the West Sussex County Council website.

Following local consultation, the first charging points are proposed at locations where existing need has been identified. To ensure the charging points are not obstructed by parked petrol/diesel vehicles, or by electric vehicles which are not being charged, it is proposed to prohibit parking by any vehicle except an electric vehicle on charge at the locations of the new charging points.

The new order is therefore proposed to improve the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

The attached table lists the drawings showing the proposed restrictions and an index of the roads affected by the proposed order.

- 4. The West Sussex County Council (Adur District) (Parking Places & Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) Order 2009 is hereby amended by the insertion of the plans specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order, attached hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE Additional Terms of Interpretation

"Electric Vehicle Recharging" means an electrically powered vehicle attached to and receiving electric charge from a public electric vehicle charging point installed and operated by West Sussex County Council or their authorised service provider.
