NOTICE is hereby given that West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic regulation Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on both sides of Eldon Way in Littlehampton, from its junction with Clun Road, westwards to its junction with Thorgate Road. The Order also prohibits waiting at any time on both sides of Clun Road at its junction with Eldon Way.

Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order

West Sussex County Council proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order that will prohibit waiting at any time (introduce double yellow lines) on both sides of Eldon Way in Littlehampton, from its junction with Clun Road, westwards to its junction with Thorgate Road. The Order also prohibits waiting at any time on both sides of Clun Road at its junction with Eldon Way.

A new youth centre is to be constructed on land to the north of Eldon Way, at the site of the current Keystone Centre building. A road safety audit for the project identified the likelihood of young people frequently crossing Eldon Way from the new building to reach the recreation ground on the opposite site of the road and recommended prohibiting parking to provide a clear view of approaching traffic. The opportunity is being taken to extend the lines to the junction of Eldon Way with Clun Road. This junction is presently protected with single yellow lines, which are considered inadequate because parking at this location creates potential hazard at the junction at any time of day.

The new order is therefore proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the affected lengths of road and to facilitate the passage of traffic.

The attached drawing, numbered TQ0103SES shows the lengths of roads affected by the proposed order.




